

**TWENTY-FOURTH ANNUAL LIP SYNC CONTEST

The Mifflin-Juniata Special Needs Center is preparing for the Twenty-Fourth Annual Lip Sync Contest! This year's contest will be held on **Saturday, February 26, 2011** at 6:00 PM *in* the Lewistown Area High School auditorium. Prizes will be awarded according to the number of entrants. *The* criteria used to judge each act are Costume and/or Set, Synchronization, Audience Response, Use of Comedy and/or Drama, Choreography, and Overall Impression. **The Special Needs Center reserves the right to limit the number of acts.**

Anyone wishing to participate should bring the attached application, the \$10.00 registration fee, and their music in it's **original** CD to the Mifflin-Juniata Special Needs Center, 31 South Dorcas Street, Lewistown. **All music and a description/introduction of the act must be included with the application. Your introduction will be used by the emcee to introduce your act and is a good way to get the audience "in the mood" for your number.** All the materials are due at the Center by **Friday, February 11, 2011.**

RULES

1. All participants must be pre-registered with a completed application.
2. All music for the program must be the **original** C.D.
3. Acts can be no longer than **5 (five) minutes**.
4. Each performer or group must have a name to enter. It may be the name of the group you are imitating or one of your own.
5. Should two groups enter with the same song, the one with the earliest entry date will be permitted to use that number in the show.
6. Only one song may be entered per group or individual performer.
7. Each performer or group is responsible for bringing their own props. Props should be as mobile as possible so that you can move them on and off the stage easily and quickly.
8. Groups/individuals may not enter acts they have presented in earlier Lip Sync contests.
9. Please remember that this is a family show. All music, dances, and moves must be appropriate for people of any age.

Note: The Special Needs Center must approve all songs and acts, and reserves the right to reject any performances.

Each group/individual will have a scheduled rehearsal time for Saturday morning or afternoon, February 26, 2011 at the LAHS auditorium. You may bring your props and costumes at that time if you wish.
